## HESTER MEETS WRIGHT

wners of a small but very well-conceived La Jolla home originally designed by the late great architect Henry Hester asked interior designer Robert Wright to refresh the master bath. "The existing bathroom was basically exhausted and needed refurbishment and updating," Wright says. "A particular request was to maximize the storage and emphasize the small garden atrium, and design the room in a modern style more in keeping with the architecture of the home."

To add warmth, Wright chose medium-toned woods for the cabinetry and detailing of the windows, doors and molding. To infuse the space with a spa-like ambience, he selected the same lighthued marble for the shower walls, counters and heated flooring

Other features include the Soft Tub soaking tub, specified for safety and comfort, along with plumbing fixtures by Waterworks and decorative lighting by Boyd Lighting.

The darker beams and a carved wood wall sculpture dress up and direct the eye to the beautiful atrium.
